

In early March, we begin this year's Lenten season. For our midweek services we will follow the prophetic messages of The Suffering Servant and see that the Servant is Jesus, Himself.

Our first service is on Ash Wednesday, March 6, with others on March 13, 20, 27, and April 3, and 10.

All services will begin at 7:00 p.m. There will not be any morning services year. Come to these services to fully prepare for a joyous celebration of Easter.

At 6:00 p.m. there will be the Traditional Lenten Potluck Supper but this year with a twist. The entrée will be provided and you can bring your favorite side.

#### The Menu:

That resulted in a number of injuries, including broken ribs, broken collarbone, brain bleed, and other complications. My time through the end of the year was spent in the hospital, a Rehab center, and on home therapy

As is, often the case with this type of injury, one thing leads to another. While some of the problems have resolved themselves, others have not. Currently, my big problems are balance along with the ability to stand and walk. That is the reason I use the wheelchair all the time, even for worship services. I am seeing doctors and therapists with the hope of being able to walk as I did before the fall.
